farmhouse vineyards

Clove followed by rhubarb, strawberries, and rose...this wine provides a wonderful toasty oak and spice aromatic that will not stop. With a bright finish of currant, subtle hints of raspberry and clove, Counoise is a light-bodied red wine varietal. Traditionally it is used to blend with Grenache, Syrah, and Mourvèdre and is one of the sanctioned varietals used in Chateauneuf du Pape. Gentle processing of this grape during warm fermentation brings florals and fruit characteristics to the forefront. Aging in neutral oak barrels promotes warmth, accenting the inherent fruit, yielding strawberries, with a soft tannin structure. Enjoy now, age 3-5 years.

Aromatics: Rose petals, cherries, black tea and mild dried herbs

On the Palate: Cherries, cranberries, raspberries, and brown baking spices - creating a soft creamy mouthfeel with medium acidity and light tannins

Service: Decant 30 minutes - Serve 60°-65°F

Raised by the Wilmeth family in Tokio, Texas, 2019 proved to be a formidable grape-growing year. Replete with cardamom, violets, and ground allspice on the nose, following with balanced fruit and savory flavors. Enjoy now, age 3-5 years.

Aromatics: Hibiscus tea, black fig preserves, ground allspice, violets

On the Palate: Cranberries, blackberries, figs, Kalamata olives, bright acidity, mild tannins, vanilla

Service: No decant necessary - Serve 58°-65°F, in medium-bodied, aromatic glassware



2019 BARBERA
tallent vineyard

The Tallent Vineyard Barbera is always a source of pride at Becker Vineyards. This ancient Italian varietal grown “for the people” has a beautiful presence here in the Texas Hill Country and we are excited to share this with our people. The 2019 vintage represents scorching summer producing ripe fruit, with complete, yet soft tannins, while retaining its lively acidity.

Fragrant red fruits, tarragon, and subtle anise greet you, opening to boysenberry and brown sugar. Aging in predominantly American oak barrels lends notes of coffee, tea, complementing red cherry and rhubarb fruits. Enjoy now or age for the next 5+ years.

Aromatics: Bright red fruits, mint, tarragon, cocoa

On the Palate: Red cherries, raspberries, subtle fennel, chocolate mint, bright acidity, medium-to-light bodied, soft, well-structured tannins

Service: Decant 30 minutes - Serve in glassware for medium-bodied, aromatic wines, 58°-65°F

2019 MALBEC RESERVE

The 2019 Malbec Reserve hails from the Tallent Vineyard, located in Mason County, TX. Granite, limestone, and hickory sandstone soils provide excellent growth for these Malbec grapes, consistently providing beautiful wines.

Malbec is complemented by Tannat, Petite Sirah and Petit Verdot, yielding a full-bodied wine rich in red fruits and savory herbal notes. Aging this vintage in predominantly American oak barrels for two years allows firm tannins, juicy fruits in a lively wine. This wine was made to pair with your favorite leaner meats and savory mushroom sauces. Enjoy now, age 5+ years.

Aromatics: Pomegranate, dried herbs, cranberry, cherries, tomato leaf

On the Palate: Dried herbs, thyme, tart currant, red plum, petrichor with a slate finish, medium plus acidity and tannins

Service: Decant 30 minutes - Serve 58°-65°F

2018 ROUSSANNE RESERVE
farmhouse vineyards

Originating in the Rhone region of France, this late-ripening white grape yields intense aromas, deep, gold hue, and full flavor. Grown on the Texas High Plains in Meadow, TX, our Roussanne displays fantastic minerality, bright fruit and herbal notes. A cold fermentation in tank with partial malolactic fermentation creates a crisp, yet creamy medium-bodied wine. Enjoy now, age 3-5 years

Aromatics: Gardenia, citrus notes of lemon, lime zest, with beeswax and pear

On the Palate: Meyer lemon, lime, round, full mouthfeel, over-ripe apricot and honeycomb

Service: No decant necessary - Serve 50-55°F

2017 CHARDONNAY RESERVE
canada family vineyard

We are, once again, so honored to present our Chardonnay Reserve from the Canada Family Vineyards. Vines ranging in age from 4 years to 35 years, are meticulously maintained by Brenda, Dewayne and Daniel Canada in Plains, TX. The wine is full-bodied, rich with citrus, overripe tree fruit and melons, balanced with the minerality driven from the black, granitic soil in which the grapevines thrive. We take this wine very seriously and are equally meticulous with the fermentation and barrel aging program. French barrels are purchased new for these grapes every year, but a choice selection of new and mildly used barrels is chosen for aging. Two years in French oak barrels lends a buttery nose that quickly opens to Asian pears, a creamy palate of almonds, ripe mango, and a twist of lemon peel. Enjoy now, age 5-7 years.

Aromatics: Almonds, petrichor, buttery nuances with ripe tree fruit and citrus flowers

On the Palate: Toasty brioche and ripe tropical fruits, mango and citrus

Service: No decant necessary - Serve at 55°F
