

Our 2021 Mourvèdre is a testament to resilience and skill in Texas winemaking, crafted during a challenging vintage. The year began with an unprecedented snowstorm, setting the stage for a growing season fraught with harsh weather.

Texas vineyards faced relentless hurdles: hailstorms, disease pressures, and extreme temperature drops, all contributing to a reduced crop. Yet, these same challenges allowed the grapes that survived to develop exceptional concentration and depth, as the cool picking season extended their time on the vine. This blend of Mourvèdre, Cinsault, and Counoise captures the vintage's distinctive character. Aged for 34 months in American Oak, the result is a remarkable wine that truly embodies the strength and artistry of Texas viticulture.

### Recommended Pairings:

Beef short ribs, shiitake mushrooms, rabbit

Cabernet Franc, one of the parent grapes of Merlot and Carménère, as well as the global superstar Cabernet Sauvignon, has been a key component of red Bordeaux blends in France since the 17th century. Often referred to by its nickname, 'Cab Franc,' it is generally lighter-bodied than Cabernet Sauvignon, and has earned a reputation as a supporting player in some of the world's most famous and sought-after wines. However, when carefully grown and crafted in the cellar, it can beautifully stand on its own as a varietal bottling. We believe the unique traits of the 2019 vintage brought out a true gem of Cab Franc, sourced from a selection of our West Texas growers, and very much worthy of standing alone. With good acidity and soft tannins, enjoy the aromas of pepper, tobacco, and red berries, paired with anything from roasted chicken to savory beef dishes.

The 2023 Jolie Rosé is crafted with intentionality and elegance, made from 80% direct-press Grenache and 20% saignée from select lots, achieving a vibrant and delicate blend inspired by the wines of Provence.

This vintage showcases the character of the challenging season, where extreme weather conditions pushed winemakers to truly refine their craft. The result is a beautifully aromatic rosé that captures the terroir's resilience and spirit.

It's sourced primarily from Tallent Vineyards in Mason, Texas and was aged in stainless steel for 6 months to preserve vibrant flavors and aromas.

Pair it with fresh, light fare like melon, bruschetta, or fresh mozzarella to accentuate its floral and fruit-forward notes.

# RED PREMIER CLUB

Becker Vineyards' Non-Vintage Sangiovese is a layered blend that celebrates the best qualities of multiple harvests. Composed of 85% Sangiovese with hints of Dolcetto, Barbera, and Petite Sirah, this wine

balances elegance and depth. Each sip offers velvet-rich textures and captivating notes of cherry, roasted tomato, and espresso. Crafted from a mix of vintages spanning 2014 to 2022, this non-vintage blend showcases a complexity and freshness that would be hard to achieve in a single year. Sourced primarily from Becker's own estate, this Sangiovese is a rare and expressive take on a classic varietal.



Our 2020 Petite Sirah is a bold, Texas Hill Country expression crafted from Becker Estate and Tallent Vineyards, with a hint of Counoise from the Farmhouse Vineyards. This wine offers a complex tapestry of flavors, beginning with aromas of rich blueberries, figs, fresh leather, and violets. Aged primarily in neutral American oak, it showcases ripe dark fruits balanced with smoky Mesquite and medium tannins, leading to a lush, lingering finish. On the palate, expect layers of blueberry jam, espresso, sweet tobacco, and black tea.

Smoked gouda macaroni & cheese,  
stuffed portobello mushrooms, dark chocolate chili

This vintage of Chardonnay Reserve, crafted from the Canada Family Vineyards in the Texas High Plains and Tallent Vineyards in the Texas Hill Country, showcases a harmonious balance of both regions' fruit. Fermented and aged sur lie in French Allier barrels, it offers a rich mouthfeel with notes of toasted oak, baking spices, Golden Delicious apples, tropical fruit, white pepper, and warm vanilla.

### Recommended Pairings:

White fish, chicken pasta,  
Texas Hill Country Pecans

Viognier has long been established as the white grape of Texas and our 2022 Viognier Reserve is 100% Texas, 100% Viognier and 100% sourced from Six Harts Vineyards in Tokio, Texas.

Texas Viognier has come along way since Dr. Becker first planted it commercially in 1994 and we're confident you will find this bottling to be quintessential Viognier in its aromatic palette and mouth feel.

### Recommended Pairings:

Bacon wrapped scallops, lentils with pork belly, creme brulée
