

## 2014 Pinot Grigio

Pinot Grigio has a remarkable story coming from the Burgundy region of France as early as 1300 – making a global journey that includes Austria, Germany, South Africa, Chile, Argentina, New Zealand and finally North America, into California, Oregon and Texas. This grape is usually associated with cooler grape growing climates. However, here in Texas it is doing quite well. The melon and apple notes come forward in the warmer climate, but the acid stays in balance. We harvest our Pinot Grigio from Mason County here in the Hill Country. You cannot ask for a better white wine from our area – light, crisp and full of rich flavor.


